Remarks from Mr. Skelton

Thank you to the PTA for the special recognition of the support staff yesterday.

Items from County mtg last week:

Re-opening plans-caseloads are down, worst numbers in Feb. Would like all to return to in person learning. There will be an opt. out option but it will not look like this year's Digital Learning. It would not be concurrent. Digital Learning may be by cluster (may not be with home school). We have had 69% of students in-person and this number will increase to 80% mid-March.

Teacher vaccinations will begin next week at Gwinnet Place Mall. May cause minimal disruptions as teachers have to go upon appointment. This could be during the day. May see a few more substitutes as a result. Vaccinations are offered on a 4-tier basis—depends on position and their closeness to working with students. Currently the County is planning on 4 people from each building a day.

5th Grade promotional ceremony. The current restrictions are that schools are unable to use buses to transport students. This leaves the school with an evening option or day celebration at the school. Looking at several options. 1)Weather dependent after hours or Sat at the HS stadium. This would allow teachers and students on one side and Parents on the other. Early May is the option for this due to the track being under construction later in May. 2)Holding a playground ceremony at night or on a Sat. In this situation it would have to be a ticketed event. May have to hold two teams at one night and two teams on another.

Milestones testing will take place this year. This will not be a promotion retention test this year. Will happen the week of May 10th.

Summer school will be offered this summer for all grades K-5th. The focus will be on the standards for the upcoming year. This will be the case across the county.



Rising 6th grade information will be going out soon. Mrs. Law plans to hold evening meetings to allow the opportunity for rising middle schoolers to tour the school and learning about connections. This will be by appointment.
